The Bronte ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session Thursday, December 12, 2013, at 7 pm. Those in attendance were: Shane Kelton, President, Kay Styles, David McWright, Paul Williams, Ray Barnett, Jay Henderson and Alan Richey, Superintendent. Also present were David Bedford, Secondary Principal, Donna Poehls, Elementary Principal, and guests, Gina McCutchen, Nancy Cooper and Burl Lowery.

Blake Braswell arrived at 8:10 pm.

The meeting opened in prayer by Ray Barnett and the minutes were approved, as read, for the

November 2013 Board meeting. There were no audience items.

The principals reported on enrollment: Secondary – 137 with attendance rate of 95.3%, Elementary – 135 with attendance rate at 96.3 %, Total enrollment – 272. An update on student activities was also presented.

Burl Lowery, CPA, presented the 2012-2013 Financial Audit to the Board. Reporting no findings and that Bronte ISD was in good sound financial position. All were in favor.

The Board approved the retainer for Law Firm Walsh Anderson as well as Application for Texas High School Performance Schools Consortium, by resolution All were in favor.

The 2014-2015 Fairview Alternative Co-op Shared Services Arrangement Contract was reviewed and approved. All were in favor.

The Board also approved the West Texas Food Service Co-op Agreement. All were in favor. Early Release dates and Bad Weather make-up day were discussed. Early release dates are December 20, 2013, April

18, 2014, and May 29, 2014. Bronte ISD will make up the bad weather day on April 18th. By Resolution to Cast Ballot for Board Director for the Coke County Appraisal District, Bronte ISD Board of Trustees placed all of their votes toward Michael Cervenka. All were in favor.

Mr. Richey, Superintendent, updated the Board on bus repair issues. The Board was informed of the Faculty Christmas party and the next board meeting was set for January 23, 2014.

The Board went into Executive session at 8 pm and resumed the Regular meeting at 8:23 pm.

A motion was made to pay the December 2013 bills. The meeting adjourned at 8:24 pm.

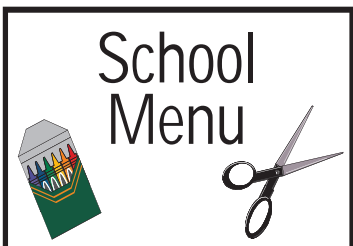
