Coke County donations have amounted to more than \$3,000 in the past.

Fifteen time Grammy® Award winner Ricky Skaggs' career is among the significant in recent country music history. If Skaggs³ burgeoning trophy case full of awards wasn't already enough evidence of that fact, consider that legendary guitarist Chet Atkins once credited Skaggs with "singlehandedly saving country music." His life's path has taken him to various musical genres, from where it all began in bluegrass music, to striking out on new musical journeys, while still leaving his musical roots intact.

With their debut single, "Lipstick," Runaway became the first all-female trio in over a decade to score a Top 25 hit.
