The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session Tuesday, December 14, 2016, in the Robert Lee ISD Conference Room 119 at 5 pm. The meeting was called to order by President Washam with the following members present: Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, George Grim, Tom Sawyer, Irma Torres, Erin Oleksiuk, and Beverly Sinclair. The Invocation and pledge were led by Beverly Sinclair.

Supt. Hood held a Public Hearing on School FIRST for Robert Lee ISD. Robin Allen read the Annual Financial Management Report for the district's year ending August 31, 2016.

Erin Oleksiuk made a motion to approve the minutes of November 17, 2016, seconded

by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

George Grim made a motion to approve the financial reports and budget amendment as presented by Robin Allen and to approve the bills, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.

Enrollment for grades 7-12 was 111 and attendance rate was 97.9% for the month of November. Supt. Hood gave the elementary principal's report, along with the activities of the

high school campus; elementary enrollment for September was 171 students and 96% attendance rate.

Robin Allen gave the report of Continuing Education hours of the Board Members: Wes Washam 153.10, Jeffie Roberts 115.05, Beverly Sinclair 61.75, Erin Oleksiuk 21.25, Tom Sawyer 104.35, Irma Torres 130.55, George Grim 22.50 and Supt. Hood 65.60.
