County Stock Show slated for January 14-15

The 83rd edition of the Coke County Junior Livestock Show will be held Friday, January 14, and Saturday, January 16, at the Sterling Lindsey Exhibition Building in Robert Lee.

The event will begin on Friday with official weigh in of animals at 10 am in the following order: steers, pigs, lambs, goats, rabbits. The market steer show will then begin at 5 pm.

The show will begin on Saturday at 8:30 am with the market pig show, followed by the pig pee wee showmanship, market lamb show, market goat show, lamb and goat pee wee showmanship, and rabbit show in that order. The premium sale will be held then at 1 pm.

Barn cleanup will be held on Sunday at 2 pm and all exhibitors are asked to please

help clean up the barns and pens.

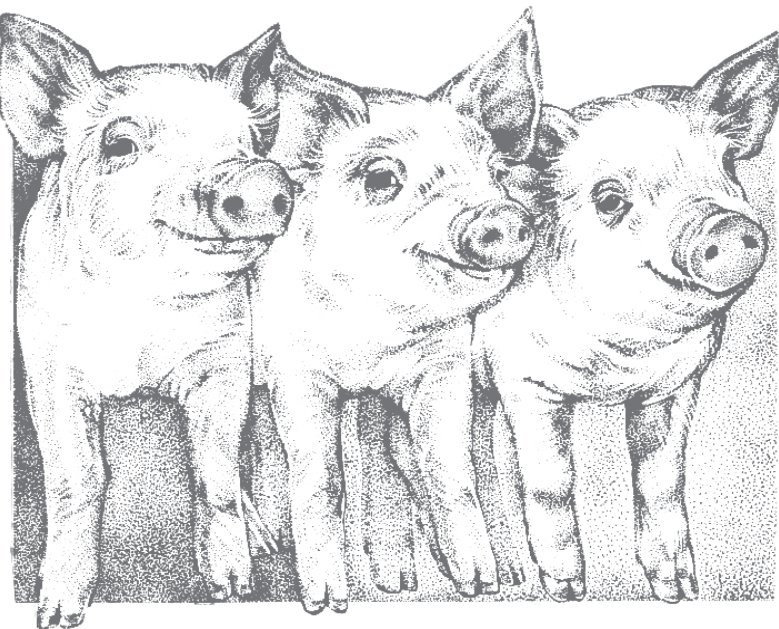
If those needing this service are unfamiliar with ordering online, assistance is also available with that part of the process.
