Ricky Royall reports that Bug Express has been out to spot treat the weeds at the cemetery.

There was nothing to report on the status of the depot.

Building Permit Committee reviewed and approved seven building permits in the month of September. They include one carport, one fence, three storage buildings, and two additions to existing homes. There were no denied permits.
