The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met in regular session Wednesday, December 17, 2014, at 6:45 pm. The meeting was called to order by President Washam.

Members present included Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, Beverly Sinclair, Tom Sawyer, George Grim, Erin Oleksiuk and Irma Torres. No members were absent.

The Invocation and pledge were led by Beverly Sinclair

Cathy Pitcock from Eckert & Company presented the 2013-2014 Robert Lee ISD Audit report. Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve the Audit as presented, seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the minutes of November 20, 2014, seconded by Irma Torres. All voted for.

Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve the financial reports given by Robin Allen and to approve the bills, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.

Enrollment for grades 7-12 was 108 and attendance rate was 95.5% for the month of November. Supt. Hood gave the elementary principals report; elementary enrollment for November was 158 students and 94.8% attendance rate.

Robin Allen presented the Board with Continuing Education Hours for each member; Wes Washam 241.35, Jeffie Roberts 105.05, Beverly Sinclair 51.75, Erin Oleksiuk 11.25, Tom Sawyer 94.35, Irma Torres 122.55, and George Grim 9.50.

Supt. Hood recommended declaring by Resolution that 4-H is an extracurricular activity. Tom Sawyer made a motion, seconded by Beverly Sinclair, to approve the Resolution as presented. All vote for.

Supt. Hood recommended naming Morgan Runyan, Coke County Extension Agent as Adjunct Faculty for 4-H. Jeffie Roberts made a motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Beverly Sinclair. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended to request an Expedited Waiver for Timeline for Accelerated Instruction. Erin Oleksiuk made a motion to approve recommendation as presented, seconded by Tom Sawyer. All voted for.

Supt. Hood recommended signing to request an Expedited Waiver for Staff Development. Irma Torres made a motion to approve recommendation, seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All voted for.

Supt. Hood gave his respective report on enrollment numbers,

Thanksgiving Meal Numbers and read thank you notes.

The Board went into closed session at 7:22 pm and reconvened into open session at 8 pm.
