August Pfluger will hold a meet and greet from 5 pm to 7 pm Wednesday, January 29, 2019, at The Blue Goose in downtown Bronte. He is running in the Republican Primary on March 3, 2020, for the Texas District 11 US Representative seat. Longtime US Representative Michael Conaway is retiring.

Lt. Col. August Pfluger is a twenty year veteran of the US Air Force and a decorated combat pilot with over 300 hours of direct action against radical jihadists in the Islamic State in Iraq and Syria (ISIS). Until launching his campaign for TX-11 in September, August served as a member of President Donald Trump's National Security Council staff, where he was entrusted with our nation's highest security clearance and

charged with advising President Trump on a host of foreign and domestic threats to our nation's security.
