Bronte ISD Board Meeting minutes told

October 11, 2018

The Bronte ISD Board of Trustees held a regularly scheduled meeting on October 11, 2018.

Those in attendance included Board Members Shane Kelton, Ashley Braswell, Terry Queen, Blake Braswell, Jodie Arrott, Josh Schoenfield, and Administration Members Tim Siler, John Phillips, and Jenny Baker.

The meeting was opened at 7:34 pm with a prayer by Terry Queen.

A quorum was established at 7:35 pm with six members present. Board Member John Seales was absent.

The minutes for the regular September meeting were presented and read. A motion was made by Jodie Arrott to approve the minutes as presented and was seconded by Terry Queen. Ayes: 6, Nays: 0. The motion passed.

Ashley Braswell made a motion to approve the bill listing and was seconded by Blake Braswell. Ayes: 6, Nays: 0. The motion passed.

There were no audience items.

Principal's Report

Update on Student Activities - Mr. Phillips presented a quick update on activities. This is the second week of the second six weeks. There were failures. Homecoming is next week; there will be no parade for this year. The fall festival is tentatively scheduled for October 29, 2018. Red Ribbon Week will take place the last week of October. The band contest is in two weeks.

Student Counts and ADA - Total BISD enrollment of 244, which is up from 234 in September 2018. ADA is 97.5%.

Superintendent's Report

Finance Update - Mr. Siler gave an update on school finances. He advised that Mr. Lowery is in the middle of the

audit. He also advised that while it is still early, he thinks the end of the year will end up fine if the trend holds. The budget was built on a refined ADA of 200 and current refined ADA is 220. This is the first year for the new First Rating.

Misc. Updates - Mr. Siler advised that everything is going great and there is nothing to report. BISD will need to look at possibly buying another short bus if the budget allows after the end of the year.

A budget amendment is needed to adjust payroll for new hire. Blake Braswell made a motion to amend the budget as presented and was seconded by Josh Schoenfield. Ayes: 6, Nays: 0. The motion passed.

This is the yearly reoccurrence of approving by resolution the Coke County Extension Agents

to be adjunct faculty members so that they will be able to supervise the 4-H students attending stock shows. Ashley Braswell made a motion to approve Adjunct Faculty Requests as presented and was seconded by Terry Queen. Ayes: 6, Nays: 0. The motion passed.

The Board did not enter into Executive Session.

There was no correspondence.

Blake Braswell made a motion to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Ashley Braswell. Ayes: 6, Nays: 0. The meeting was adjourned at 8 pm.
