The filing period for the May 1, 2021, local government entity elections began Wednesday, January 13, 2021, and will end Friday, February 12, 2021. Ordinarily, there is a full year between elections. Due to Covid, there is only a six month period between the 2020 election and the 2021 election. The last local entity election was held in conjunction with the general election on November 3, 2020.

The City of Robert Lee will hold an election for the council member terms currently held by Becca McGuire and Tracy Grantham. The seat vacated by Jason Moran when he was elected Mayor is also on the

#### Scholarship opportunities available for upcoming graduates **Lone Star Ag Credit**

Lone Star Ag Credit will be awarding six graduating seniors a \$2,500 scholarship in 2021. In addition, the FFA chapter or 4-H club of the the scholarship winners will also receive \$500. Applicants must be graduating in the spring of 2021 and submit their application no later than March 16, 2021 (must be postmarked by this date). The application must include three copies of the following:

- Application form (available online at lonestaragcredit.com)
  - Resume containing work

experience, community service, organizational involvement, and leadership positions

- List of honors, awards, and special accomplishments
- Current transcript of grades
- Two letters recommendation from agricultural leaders (for example: teacher, farmer, rancher, extension agent, elected official)
- Two page essay sharing how agriculture and natural resources play a part in your life and what roles they'll serve in your future and career.

### **Texas Farm Bureau**

Texas Farm Bureau has several scholarships available. The Dick Mitchell Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship awarded to one high school senior who has attended the Texas Farm Youth Bureau Leadership Conference Virtual or Leadership Conference.

The Young Farmer and Rancher Scholarship is for high school seniors pursuing a degree in agriculture. Each of Texas Farm Bureau's 13 districts will award one \$1,000 scholarship.

To acknowledge former Texas Farm Bureau president S.M. True Jr., a \$20,000 scholarship was established for college students enrolled in an undergraduate degree program with at least 60 hours of college credit and who have declared agriculture as their major. Applicants must submit a completed application and two letters of recommendation - one from the county Farm Bureau president and one from teh dean or head of the agriculture department of their college or university.

The Young Farmer and Rancher Enrolled Scholarship is for students already enrolled university to which the student in college pursuing their has been accepted. Application undergraduate degrees. Applicants must have completed a minimum of 45 credit hours and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher to qualify. Three \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded.
