The Trapper's Report for October 1 through October 31 was presented by Judge Blair.  
No action was taken on the burn ban.  
Commissioner Sefcik moved to approve the bonds for Monica Reyes, Hal Spain, and Lorrie Martin. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.  
Commissioner Sefcik moved to approve the Green Mountain Ranch Restrictions, Covenants, and Sub-Division Plat fro LTC Ranch Group. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Millican and carried.  
Commissioner Millican moved to accept the donation of caliche for road repair on a portion of Green Mountain Road from Sam Poorman. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, carried.  
Commissioner Millican moved to appoint Hal Spain, Judge Elect as Designation of General Assembly, Executive Committee, Transit District and Emergency Preparedness Advisory Member representing Coke County, effective January 1, 2019. The

motion was seconded by Commissioner Sefcik and carried.  
Commissioner Millican moved to appoint Commissioner Williams as Judge Pro-Tem for Calendar Year 2019. The motion, seconded by Commissioner Sefcik, carried.  
No action was taken on the Interlocal Agreement between Coke County and City of Robert Lee.  
Treasurer Hal Spain reported on Heritage Insurance.  
Commissioner Robertson moved to pay bills and was seconded by Commissioner Millican. The motion carried.

The Bronte City Council met in regular session on Thursday, October 18, 2018, at 6:30 pm.  
Those in attendance included Mayor Paul Gohman, Councilman Steve Hines, Councilman Lee Wommack, Councilman Santiago Rodriguez, Councilman Stormy Vaughn, Utilities Director Ricky Royall, City Secretary Teresa Ballard, and Deputy City Secretary Sherry Bailey. City Attorney Eileen M. Hayman and Mayor Pro Tem David

Bedford were absent.  
The pledge was recited by those in chambers and the prayer was offered by Mayor Paul Gohman.  
**Citizen Comments**  
Howard Baker purchased property from the Mr. Barbee family about 4 - 5 years ago on the east side of the cemetery. At the time he owned 50% of the land and the other 50% was owned by the Pruitt's. They failed to pay their taxes for several years. Mr. Baker shared a map showing where the Barbees donated a portion to the City for the cemetery. Mr.

Baker has been researching what the status of the other 50%. After going back and forth with the county appraisal office and attorneys, he gets referred to the City of Bronte. Mr. Baker sent a letter expressing interest in the property. It is understood that the city/attorney sent out letters to the 32-33 heirs to the property but only received three back. Mr. Baker would like the Council to consider his offer.
