Curbside pick up to be held January 8

The City of Bronte will have inside city limits curbside pick up on Saturday, January 8. Residents are asked to have items that they would like picked up set outside Friday evening, January 7.

Acceptable items include appliances, BBQ grill without propane tank, fluorescent light bulbs, brush/limbs (cut to less than 4' length and bundled/tied, limbs too thick can damage the truck so please exercise good judgement), leaves (bagged), furniture, mattresses/box springs, carpeting (small pieces), fiberglass tub/shower, toilets, outdoor items (for example bicycle, kiddie pool, ladder, large plastic play toys, wheelbarrow, hot tub cover), lawn equipment (with all fluid removed), wooden pallets, window frames (no broken glass), white goods/appliances

(if the copper line is cut and made visible).

Unacceptable items include household trash, tires, soil, rocks, glass, shingles, roofing material, hazardous material (for example paint, household cleaners), contaminated soils, metal hangers, propane/fuel tanks, construction/remodeling material (bricks, sheetrock, insulation, flooring, etc), and no batteries of any kind.
