Students interested in taking the October 25, 2014 ACT test must register on or before September 19th, 2014 in order to avoid late fees. Students may register online at www.actstudent.org or pick up an application in the high school counselor's office. The cost of the ACT test is \$38.00 or \$54.50, if a student registers for the ACT Plus Writing test. If someone is unsure which test to sign up for, please consult the high school counselor.

Students interested in taking the October 11, 2014 SAT Test must register on or before September 12th in order to avoid late fees. Another SAT Test will be administered November 8th.
