Brontoberfest set for October 22

Restoring Bronte Foundation is gearing up to host the 2nd Annual Brontoberfest in Bronte on Saturday, October 22, 2016. Last year's event was a huge success with over 1,000 people in attendance. Over \$5,000 was raised at last year's event that went toward the park restoration efforts.

This year, RBF has changed things up a bit and expect Brontoberfest to be much bigger and better than last year. Added events to this year's Brontoberfest include additional beer/wine vendors, added music around town, and a food truck court. The main events have not changed, but will be improved. An event, Nine at Night lighted golf tournament, has been added for Friday night at 8 pm.

The Brontoberfest events will include a cook-off with over twenty-five teams, craft beer and local wine vendors throughout the downtown area, multiple vendors and artists, German inspired foods, food truck court, German vehicle show, and activities for children and young people, including a ice cream freeze off, a bounce house, 3 point tournament, and horseless goat roping. All the events lead up to a concert Saturday night featuring Zane Williams and Kramer LaBarge.

This event is a version of Oktoberfest but with a kick of West Texas added in!

One hundred percent of the profit will go toward the park restoration project.
