September 10, 2020, Special Meeting

The Bronte City Council met in special session on Thursday, September 10, 2020, at Bronte City Hall at 5:30 pm. An audio recording can be requested through the Public Information Act through City Hall.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm by Mayor Paul Gohman and a quorum was established. Those in attendance included council members Steve Hines, Ron Cooper, Stormy Vaughn, and Lee Wommack, Utilities Director Ricky Royall, and City Secretary Teresa Ballard. Council member Santiago Rodriguez was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Paul Gohman and prayer was offered by Lee Wommack.

Stormy Vaughn made the motion to approve the ordinance terminating the repealing automatically allowance for updated service credits under the TMRS System, effective December 1, 2020. She was seconded by Steve Hines and the motion

passed with vote of 4 - 0. Stormy Vaughn made the motion to approve the ordinance to increase rate of

deposits to the TMRS System for the employees of Bronte, with an increase of 7%, effective December 1, 2020. She was seconded by Ron Cooper and the motion passed with a vote of

Teresa Ballard did not give the council the correct cost of the license that council approved last month. Stormy Vaughn made the motion to approve adding another general ledger license only. The council will wait on the Cemetery License with Asyst Software and approving of the City Secretary to electronically for invoices. She was seconded by Ron Cooper and the motion passed with a vote of 4 - 0.

The goal of the workshop is for the mayor and city council members to share and discuss elements of the FY2020-2021 Operating Budget.

The Council looked over the proposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget for General, Water, Sewer, Sanitation, Cemetery, and Grant Funds. Ricky Royall reported that the city did get an added \$5,000 from fund balance to offset not going up on base rate, tier one and two water rates. Ricky Royall also reported a \$7,000 purchase of equipment, adding the mower. Sewer is transferring \$10,000 The city increased Cemetery. expenses 3% per Republic Services contract yearly Sanitation expenses. The Convenience Center budget is being left alone for now. Money will be saved on curbside expense with not sending out postcards and postage. Sanitation is still being discussed. The council wants to meet with Republic Services to discuss the contract. Teresa Ballard will email Joe Spano to come to a council meeting to bring the new contract with having monthly curbside, 5-year contract with a 90-day termination clause.

Funds in the amount of \$12,000 from General, \$10,000 from Sewer, and \$10,000 from Sanitation will be transferred to the Cemetery Fund. The funds, totaling \$22,000, will be used for landscaping, spraying, and inmate expense.

The city has applied for grants. The council would like to citizens to see that grants have been applied for to show on the budget. Teresa Ballard will ask the auditor about showing it in the budget that grants have been applied for.

With there being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:31 pm.
