The Council discussed water meters at residence city ordinance along with T.C.E.Q.. Mrs. Thorn will rewrite section 3 of city ordinance to include wording from T.C.E.Q..

The Council discussed depot use and liability. Mrs. Thorn will look into event insurance and cost of the event insurance.

Mrs. Bedford made a motion to approve increasing the per diem to \$46 a day. Mr. Stautzenberger seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The Council discussed the Baker water wells. There is nothing to report at this time.

The Council discussed water well information from Gid Ware. The well tested is the deepest well and the other wells are not as deep. The City may need to drill a test well.

Mr. Royall informed the council of the need to purchase 2 loads of coal mix at approximately \$3,300 per load. The City has to replace 1.5 loads to Coke County and .5 a load belongs to the city. Mr. Royall
