West Coke County Hospital District Board of Directors meetings held

September 10, 2019

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met for the second Budget Hearing Tuesday, September 10, 2019. President Pat Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:30 am and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Noel Tinkler, Beverly Burdett, and Robert Brock. Houston McGuire - RLCC Administrator, and Janie Munoz - BOM were also present at the meeting. The invocation was given by Pat Stephens. The Board adjourned to go into regular session at 10 am.

There were no visitors. The Board adjourned into regular meeting at 10:03 am.

The Board voted to approve the tax rate of .25 per hundred for the upcoming fiscal year, and also to accept the WCCHD budget as proposed.

The longevity bonus for employees was discussed and a motion was approved to keep the longevity bonus the same as last year.

The board authorized Houston to research the possibility to have a locked unit at the facility, and also obtain bids for aesthetic improvements to be made to the facility.

The board voted to accept a bid from Byteable Solutions to replace the outdated camera security system, and also to continue to pay the cost of the insurance premium for basic coverage for the employees.

The board voted to pay for one CNA/med aide per year to attend LVN school, with a signed 2-year employment contract following certification, with a cap of \$8500. In a separate motion, the board also voted to pay for current attendee.

Future agenda items were discussed.

The Board entered Executive Session at 11:15 am and exited at 11:55 am. No action was taken.

After a delicious meal at the facility, the Board adjourned at 12:20 pm.

September 24, 2019

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session Tuesday, September 24, 2019. President Pat Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:30 am and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Pat Carwile, Beverly Burdett, and Robert Brock. Houston McGuire - RLCC Administrator, Roger Alexander - WCCHD Administrator, Chris Martin - Consultant, and Janie Munoz - BOM were also present at the meeting. The invocation was given by Robert Brock. There were no visitors.

There were no board members absent from the previous meeting, and the minutes from that meeting were approved.

Houston gave the administrator's report as follows. There are 35 residents in the Care Center as of the meeting date.

Accounts receivable were reviewed and discussed, and a write off for bad debts was approved. The DSO for the month is 45.

The building maintenance report included a lot of small repairs and continuing work on upkeep, but no 'big ticket' items.

Employee insurance paperwork has been signed and sent. Open enrollment for employees will be October 1-15. Houston reported that being

enrolled in a food co-op has made a considerable savings to food costs.

The financial statements were discussed and accepted.

Future agenda items were discussed.

Following a delicious meal at the facility, the board adjourned.

The next regular Board meeting will be October 29, at 9:30 am. The public is encouraged to attend.

October was kicked off in a delicious way with a Banana Split party enjoyed by the residents on October 1. Every Wednesday the beauty shop at the facility is open for the residents to 'pretty up' and that's

always a fun time. On October 11, the staff and residents enjoyed the Homecoming Parade in downtown Robert Lee. The Sing-Along, led by Roger Alexander, will be held at 3:30 pm on October 18, and everyone is invited to join the fun. The monthly un-birthday party (because there are no birthday celebrants this month) will be hosted by the FCCLA from Robert Lee High School at 2 pm on October 22.
