REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about November 9, 2011 the City of Robert Lee, Texas will submit a request to the Texas Department of Agriculture for the release of Community Development Block Grant funds under Section 104(f) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as

amended, to undertake a project known as:

PROJECT TITLE: City of Robert Lee Emergency Water Supply Improvements

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Construction activities will include the installation of a transmission line between the City of Robert Lee and the City of Bronte to include approximately 68,000 linear feet of 10-inch water line, miscellaneous fittings, approximately 320 linear feet of boring, booster pump station and metering facilities.

PROJECT LOCATION: Construction shall take place at the Robert Lee Water Treatment Plant located at the intersection of Water Plant Road and State Highway 158 and proceed east along Highway 158 to Roping Arena Road in the City of Bronte, then proceed north to Jackson Street, then

proceed east along Jackson Street to the City of Bronte Water Treatment Plant located at the intersection of Jackson Street and Washington Street.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The City of Robert Lee has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the Robert Lee City Hall, 6 E. 7th Street and may be examined or copied weekdays during the hours of 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM or 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this

determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the City of Robert Lee, P.O. Box 26, Robert Lee, Texas 76945 or to Municipal Consulting Agency at P.O. Box 851265, Richardson, Texas 75085. All comments received by November 8, 2011 will be considered by the City of Robert Lee prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Commentors should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Robert Lee certifies to the Texas Department of Agriculture that John R. Jacobs, in his capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The Department's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Robert Lee to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Texas Department of Agriculture will consider objections to its release of funds and the City of Robert Lee certification received by

November 25, 2011 or a period of fifteen days from its receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer or other officer of the City of Robert Lee approved by the Department; (b) the (RE) has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Department; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the Texas Department of Agriculture at P.O. Box 12877, Austin, Texas 78711. Potential objectors should contact the Department to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
