## Hornets make run at Cardinals

The Blackwell Hornets pushed to within three touchdowns of the Hermleigh Cardinals last Friday night. The final score was Blackwell 60, Hermleigh 81.

Jayden Jones posted 24 points on the board for the Hornets, with 3 touchdowns on the ground and 1 from the air. His stats for the night included 17 carries for 153 yards, 3 receptions for 41 yards, 1 kickoff return of 8 yards, 6 tackles and 2 assists.

Mark Monroe added 18 points for the Hornets, with 3 touchdown passes for a total of 74 yards. He returned 2 kickoffs for 8 yards, kicked off 5 times for 96 yards, had 3 tackles, 1 assist and 1 sack.

Matthew Meyers ran the

ball in 6 times on conversions to add 12 points to the Hornets' score.

Ted Chambliss caught the ball for a touchdown and put 6 points under the Hornets' column. For the evening, he had two receptions for a total of 38 yards, returned 1 kickoff for 15 yards, and had 2 tackles.

Ethan Andrews put up the 27 times with 12 completions for 204 yards and 5 touchdowns. He also carried the ball twice for 19 yards and returned 1 kickoff for 13 yards.

Kaleb Edwards carried the ball 12 times for 53 yards, had 3 receptions for 33 yards, returned the ball twice for 11 yards, had 9 tackles and 1 assist.

Mason Magness caught the ball once for 18 yards, kicked the ball 3 times for 48 yards, had 3 tackles and 1 assist.

Chase Sorrells had 1 tackle and 1 assist.

Cody Shamblin had 1 tackle and 2 assists.

The Blackwell Hornets will not play the Novice Hornets tonight. Novice had to cancel the game. However the Blackwell Junior High was able to

play Novice last night, October 20, at 6 pm in Novice.

The Hornets' next game will be against the Paint Rock Indians in Paint Rock Friday evening, October 28, at 7:30 pm.
