# Early voting for general election to be held through November 8

voting for the Early November 8, 2022, general election will begin Monday, October 24, and run through Friday, November 4. Ballots may be cast at the Coke County Courthouse in Robert Lee 8 am until 5 pm, Monday - Thursday, and 8 am until 1 pm on Friday. During this time period the back doors to the courthouse will be locked and everyone is asked to use the front entrance.

Offices up for election include County Judge, currently held by Hal Spain; County Treasurer, currently held by Therese

Emert; County/District Clerk, currently held by Monica Reyes; Justice of the Peace, currently held by Russell Johnson; and Commissioner Precinct 2, currently held by Paul Williams.

With the exception of the office of Commissioner Precinct 2, the above incumbents have all filed for re-election and will be on the ballot unopposed. Precinct 2 Commissioner Paul Williams will be joined on the ballot by Republican nominee Henry Chisholm and write-in candidate Cory Carroll.

The office of Commissioner Precinct 4 was decided back in March during the primary when incumbent Joe Sefcik was defeated by George Ray Sparks.


