ORDINANCE NO. 22-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRONTE, TEXAS; REPEALING Ordinance 19-11 dated September 19, 2019, and Ordinance 19-16, dated November 21, 2019.

WHEREAS, a person may own and keep Livestock, Fowl, Stock Show and defined Other Animals and a specific number of chickens, ducks, guineas, and turkeys. within the city, the conduct of the owner and the conditions that the Livestock, Stock Show and Other Animals are kept in, should be safe and healthy and not infringe on the surrounding homes and inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRONTE, TEXAS that Ordinance 19-11, adopted on September 19, 2019, and Ordinance 19-16 dated November 21, 2019, is hereby Repealing, Livestock Animals and Fowl Ordinance, all other provisions are in full force and effect, and that the following provisions are hereby enacted as part of the Livestock Animals and Fowl Ordinance of the City of Bronte, Texas:

VIII - VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any person, firm, or corporation found guilty of violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense; together with all costs associated with such prosecution. Each and every day the offense continues shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense. In addition to

All provisions of ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Bronte in conflict with the provision of this ordinance are and by the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed amended and repealed and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

X - SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the Amendment to the Ordinance, as a whole or any part of provision thereof, other than the part so deemed to be invalid or
