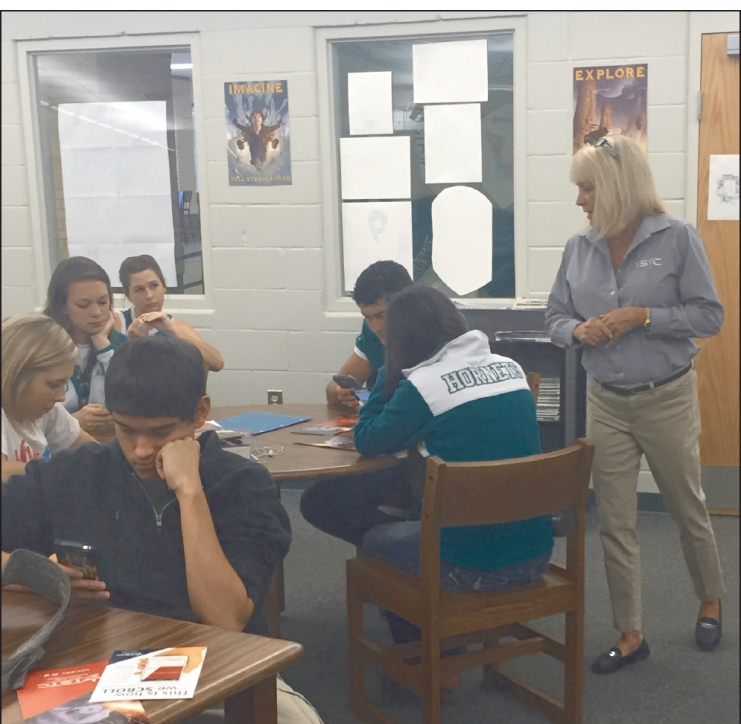

 The junior students will be taking the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) on Wednesday, November 11 at Blackwell High School.

The ASVAB is the military entrance exam which contains an aptitude test and a career interest inventory. Based on the results of the test, the students will be able to pinpoint primary interest areas that can help determine career fields that are potentially satisfying. Each junior will receive a score report and an informational booklet when the results are returned.
