Roger Alexander gave the invocation. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved, and there were no absent Board members from that meeting.

In the census count, there are currently 39 residents in the facility as of the meeting date.

In the Administrator's report staffing update, Roger reported the ongoing need of nurses and CNAs. There have been some changes in the facility since the last report. The Board would like to extend sincere congratulations to Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Patsy Cason, DON, on their retirement. We wish them the very best in the future.
