The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session on Tuesday, September 25, 2018.

President Pat Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:35 am and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Sarah Green, Pat Carwile, Beverly Burdett and Noel Tinkler. Roger Alexander, WCCHD Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting.

The invocation was given by Pat Stephens. There were no visitors. The Board minutes from the previous meeting were approved, excusing the absentee from the September 13 meeting.

There are 33 residents, with 2 pending, in the Care Center as of the meeting date. The facility is currently in need of an interim DON, part-time day nurse, an Assistant Business Office Manager, and a night CNA.

Houston reported and discussed with the Board the results of the state survey which was in progress during the August meeting. The September payment was received from QUIPP, and the DSO for the month was 39.

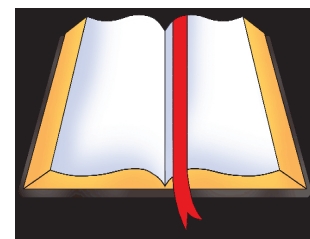
