The Robert Lee ISD Board of Trustees met on Wednesday, August 29, 2018, at 5 pm. Members present included Wes Washam, Jeffie Roberts, George Grim, Tom Sawyer, Erin Oleksiuk, and Beverly Sinclair. Member Irma Torres was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 pm by President Wes Washam and a quorum was established.

Beverly Sinclair gave the invocation, as well as leading the pledge.

Tom Sawyer made a motion to approve the minutes of August 14, 2018, and was seconded by Jeffie Roberts. All were for.

Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve the financial reports and budget amendments as presented by Robin Allen and to approve the bills. The motion was seconded by Erin Oleksiuk and all were for.

A public hearing was held on the 2018-2019 Proposed Budget.

Supt. Aaron Hood recommended adopting the 2018-2019 Official Estimated Budget by Fund and Function as presented. A motion was made by Jeffie Roberts and seconded by Tom Sawyer to approve the budget. All were for.

A public hearing was held on the 2018-2019 Proposed Tax Rate.

Sup. Hood presented the 2018-2019 Tax Rate by Ordinance; \$1.04 for the purpose of Maintenance and Operations (M&O) and \$.42 for the purpose of payment of Principal and Interest (P&I) on debts for a total of tax rate of \$1.46. George Grim made a motion to approve the Tax Rate and was seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All were for.

Supt. Hood recommended approving the Resolution for

Setting Minimum Fund Balance for Year Ending August 31, 2019. Tom Sawyer mad a motion to approve the Resolution and was seconded by Erin Oleksiuk. All were for.

Supt. Hood recommended approving the Resolution on Committed Fund Balance. The district commits \$50,000 for sick leave, \$200,000 for capital expenditures, \$100,000 for technology, and \$50,000 for land. Tom Sawyer made the motion to approve the Resolution and was seconded by George Grim. All were for.

Supt. Hood recommended approving the 2018 Certified Appraisal Roll as presented. Beverly Sinclair made a motion to approve and was seconded by
