Early voting for November general election to being October 24

Early voting for the November 8, 2022, general election will begin Monday, October 24, and run through Friday, November 4. Ballots may be cast at the Coke County Courthouse in Robert Lee 8 am until 5 pm, Monday - Thursday, and 8 am until 1 pm on Friday.

Offices up for election include County Judge, currently held by Hal Spain; County Treasurer, currently held by Therese Emert; County/District Clerk, currently held by

Monica Reyes; Justice of the Peace, currently held by Russell Johnson; and Commissioner Precinct 2, currently held by Paul Williams.

With the exception of the office of Commissioner Precinct 2, the above incumbents have all filed for re-election and will be on the ballot unopposed. Precinct 2 Commissioner Paul Williams will be joined on the ballot by Republican candidate Henry Chisholm and write-in candidate Cory Carroll.

The office of Commissioner Precinct 4 was decided back in March during the primary when incumbent Joe Sefcik was defeated by George Ray Sparks.

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session September 27, 2022, in the Board Conference Room. President Beverly Burdett called the meeting to order at 9:35 am, declared a quorum was present, and Houston McGuire led the invocation. Board members present were Pat Stephens, Betty Lewis, Roma McCarley and Noel Tinkler. Houston McGuire, Administrator, Janie Munoz, BOM, Chris Martin, Consultant and Roger Alexander, Consultant, were also present at the meeting. Lyza Frasco, Houston's shadow, also attended the meeting. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved. One absent Board member was excused from the previous meeting.

The Administrator gave his report.

In the staffing update, there is a still need for nurses. There are currently 38 residents as of the meeting date.

Danco Electric is still waiting on parts for the electrical work. The possible future start date is November.

In landscaping update, the sprinkler system has been repaired and is working well. Houston has contacted Logan Phillely of Crosscut Landscaping to complete some sod work that was delayed because of the lack of rain and extremely hot summer. There will also be some plants replaced in the landscaping that were lost because of the drought.

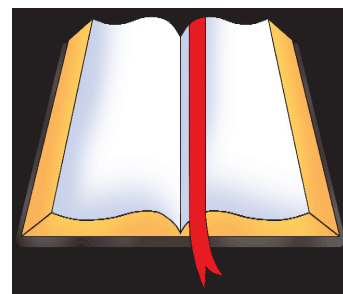
