Robert Lee's Vision with a Purpose will sponsor the Bob Wrinkle Memorial Hunters BBQ on Saturday evening, November 2. Free to area hunters, the barbecue will take place at the rec hall in the county park in Robert Lee.

The supper will include plenty of barbecued brisket and sausage, beans, potato salad, ice tea, and fixings. Serving will begin at 6 pm and will continue until 9 pm.

The feed is at no cost to hunters, but tickets are necessary. They are available

from the party from whom they lease, or from participating individuals and businesses who have supported the barbecue by donations.

The annual barbecue is only possible because of VP members and great local volunteers who do the work - preparing, cooking, serving, clean-up - and whatever it takes to make the event happen.

Area landowners and hunting lease managers may make a donation and pick up barbecue tickets at the following locations in Robert Lee: Coke County Feed and Ranch Supply and Floyd C. Pettit Insurance.

The annual barbecue has grown from about 300 the first year to as many as 1,000 hungry hunters.
