Speech Contest! In just a few weeks, Sterling City ISD student John Dain Copeland will have a chance to earn additional funds for college in Texas Farm Bureau's Free Enterprise Speech Contest. He was the winner of the Coke-Sterling County Farm Bureau district contest, earning him a \$1,500 college scholarship.

"We're pleased to be able to help Dain on his path to higher education," John Ross Copeland, Coke-Sterling County Farm Bureau president, said. "While this contest is able to help local students on their way to college, it also recognizes the importance of our constitutional government and free enterprise system."

In the Free Enterprise Speech Contest, students who are part of a Texas Farm Bureau (TFB) family, communicate through a speech the advantages of the free enterprise system and having a constitutional government. "This contest helps students learn more about our country, our economy and how to communicate well with an audience," John Ross said. "All of these things will help students greatly on the road to success." Contestants are judged on their organization, language, voice, use of notes, eye contact, persuasiveness and application of the topic in the speech. Students must attend TFB's annual Youth Leadership Conference at Tarleton State University in Stephenville to be able to participate in the Free Enterprise Speech contest. District winners like Dain will compete in the state level competition at the TFB Annual Meeting in San Antonio December 7-9. Four finalists at the state level will receive additional funding to amount to \$2,000 each, including the district scholarship. The state runners-up's scholarship will increase to \$3,000, and the state winner's will increase to \$6,000 total. An expense-paid trip to Washington, DC, next summer to meet with Texas congressional leaders and tour historic sites is also included in the prize packages.
