Noel Roger Alexander (WCCHD Administrator) Chris Martin (Interim RLCC Administrator), Janie Munoz (BOM), and Becca McGuire (DON), were also present at the meeting.

The invocation was given by Pat Stephens.

There were no visitors. One absent board member was excused from the previous meeting, and the board minutes meeting from that approved.

There are 32 residents in the Care Center as of the meeting date. In the staffing update, social worker Stephanie Steager, has been hired to fill this vacancy at the facility. Accounts receivable were discussed in depth, and a bad debt write-off was approved. Roger is working to bring the financials up to date for the November audit.
