## Deadlines

Students interested in taking the December 14, 2013 ACT test must register by Friday, November 8, 2013 in order to avoid late fees. Students may register online at www.actstudent.org or pick up an application in
the high school counselor's office. The cost of the ACT test is $\$ 36.50$ or $\$ 52.50$ if a student registers for the ACT Plus Writing test. If someone is unsure which test to sign up for, please consult the high school counselor.
Students interested in taking the December 7, 2013 SAT Reasoning Test must register before November 8th in order to avoid late fees. The cost of the SAT Reasoning test is $\$ 51.00$ and includes a required writing portion. Registration may be done o n lin e
www.collegeboard.com or you may pick up a registration packet in the counselor's office.
Fee waivers are available to junior and senior students who qualify for free or reduced lunches. Call or see Mrs. Timmerman, counselor for more information. Please keep in mind that the ACT and SAT tests will be offered several times throughout the spring semester. Free study guides are available in the counselor's office The high school library has practice test preparation books available to students.
