

Texas voters approved nine of the ten proposed Constitutional Amendments in the November 2019 Constitutional Amendment election. Coke County voters agreed with voters statewide on approving the nine and voting against one. Approximately 25% of Coke County's registered voters participated in this election. Complete results are listed below.
