Hornets advance to playoffs

It was a dream situation for a battle between two rivals. Undefeated Blackwell was down 34-29 with 41 seconds left in the game to their Nolan county archrivals from Highland before a standing room only crowd in Roscoe.

It was fourth down, with four yards needed for a first down and six yards needed for a touchdown and possible victory. Blackwell calls time out to set the offense and, after coming to the line, Highland calls time out to set their defense. Then Blackwell quarterback Brandon Brinkman found junior receiver Joe Sanchez in the end zone with 37 seconds left as Blackwell to complete not only an undefeated season, but also a district championship.

It was a battle all night long. Blackwell spotted Highland a 6-0 lead with 8:52 left in the first quarter but on Blackwell's third play from scrimmage, Michael Lowry found Hunter Clark for a 66 yard touchdown. Walls's extra point gave Blackwell the early lead, 8-6. Blackwell's offense stalled in the third quarter as Highland took a 20-8 lead at the half and the green and white faithful began to get nervous.

Hunter Clark returned the second half opening kickoff for a touchdown and Walls again put the kick through and Highland's lead was slimmed to 20-16. After Highland had taken a 28-16 lead, Blackwell struck back with a Cameron Coldiron 4 yard TD run. It was the ensuing extra point that proved the difference. The snap was bobbled, but holder Michael Lowry picked up the ball and found senior Cade McKee in the end zone for a sixman extra point of one and putting the Hornets within striking distance at 28-23. With 6:55 to go,

defeated Roscoe Highland 35-34 Brandon Brinkman would run it in from 33 yards to give Blackwell their first lead since 8-6 at 29-28. Highland would come back and score with 1:17 left in the game but missed the crucial extra point and leaving them with a precarious 34-29 lead. Following the Brinkman to Sanchez touchdown, Highland had time for four plays but the Blackwell defense knocked down passes and recorded sacks to preserve the victory.

> Although they had not played every single year, Blackwell had not defeated Highland since 2002, and as the final second ticked off the clock, fans clad in green rushed the field in celebration, prompting several of the Highland contingent to leave the field.
