Early voting ends today in November 6 General Election

Early voting in the General election ends today, Friday, November 2, and voting on Election Day, Tuesday, November 6, will be held from 7 am until 7 pm. Voters in Precincts 1 and 3 will vote at the County Courthouse in Robert Lee and Precincts 2 and 4 will cast their ballot in the fellowship hall at First Baptist Church in Bronte.

As is often the case, all of the local races were decided in the March primary election. However this year's general election may be one of the most important elections yet on the national level. Each vote matters and this year's election seems to be a team sport with party - either Republican or Democrat -

making more of a difference than in years past. In the race for United States Senator, El Paso's US Representative Robert "Beto" O'Rourke, Democrat, is challenging incumbent Ted Cruz, Republican. Also on the ballot is the Libertarian candidate, Neal M. Dikeman. In the US Representative Congressional District 11 election, Republican incumbent Mike Conaway is being challenged by Democrat JennieLou Leeder and Libertarian Rhett Rosenquest Smith.

Republican incumbent Greg Abbott is facing off against former Dallas County Sheriff Lupe Valdez, Democrat, and

Republican incumbent Dan Patrick is being challenged by Democrat Mike Collier and Libertarian Kerry Douglas McKennon in the election for Texas Lieutenant Governor.

In the election for Texas Attorney General, Republican incumbent Ken Paxton is being challenged by Democrat Justin Nelson and Libertarian Michael Ray Harris.

Republican incumbent Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts Glenn Hegar is being challenged by Democrat Joi Chevalier and Libertarian Ben Sanders.

Republican incumbent George P. Bush is being challenged by Democrat Miguel Suazo and Libertarian Matt Pina in the election for Commissioner of the General Land Office.

In the election for Texas Commissioner of Agriculture, Republican incumbent Sid Miller is being challenged by Democrat Kim Olson and Libertarian Richard Carpenter.

Republican incumbent Christi Craddick is being challenged by Democrat Roman McAllen and Libertarian Mike Write in the

election for Texas Railroad Commissioner.

Several Judicial seats are also on the ballot. For Justice, Supreme Court, Place 2, Republican Jimmy Blacklock faces Democrat Steven Kirkland. Republican John Devine faces Democrat R. K. Sandill for Justice, Supreme Court, Place 4. For Justice, Supreme Court, Place 6, Republican Jeff Brown is facing Democrat Kathy Cheng. Republican Sharon Keller will face Democrat Maria T. (Terri) Jackson and Libertarian William Bryan Strange III for Presiding Judge, Court of Criminal Appeals. For Judge, Court of Criminal Appeals, Place 7, Republican Barbara Parker

Hervey will face Democrat Ramona Franklin. For Judge, Court of Criminal Appeals, Place 8, Republican Michelle Slaughter will face Libertarian Mark Ash. Republican Cindy Olson Bourland will face Democrat Edward Smith in the election for Justice, 3rd Court of Appeals District, Place 2. For Justice, 3rd Court of Appeals District, Place 3, Republican Scott Field will face Democrat Chari Kelly. For Justice, 3rd Court of Appeals District, Place 5, Republican David Puryear will face Democrat Thomas J. Baker.
