Graveside services were at 10 am, Friday, October 26, 2018, in Robert Lee Cemetery. Services were under the direction of Shaffer Funeral Home.

Arby was born in Pumphrey, Texas, on November 11, 1936, to Wilson "Caleb" Holbrooks and Trudie Drake Holbrooks. In 1955 he graduated from Winters High School. 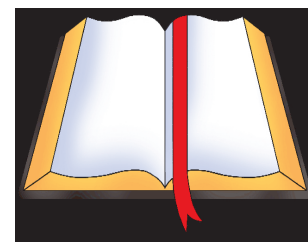
