Lincoln famously issued a Thanksgiving proclamation which, if you have never done so, I encourage you to read.

As our country was being torn about by a bitter, bloody, and seemingly never-ending civil war, Lincoln recognized the larger blessings that we all shared and asked, amidst the ugliness of war, that the people recognize "the gracious gifts of the Most High God, who, while dealing with us in anger for our hath nevertheless remembered mercy." invited the citizens to celebrate a holiday of Thanksgiving, writing that "it has seemed to me fit and proper that they should be reverently solemnly, gratefully acknowledged as with one heart and one voice by the whole American People."

As I read through the history of Thanksgiving, I can't help but notice something: holiday's most prominent developments did not occur in times of peace and tranquility.
