School Tax Rate Election results posted

election Tuesday, November 7, 2017, to raise the Bronte Independent School District tax rate from 1.04 per \$100 valuation to 1.17 per \$100 valuation passed by a vote of 110 to 73.

The rate increase will provide for approximately an additional district \$100,000 from taxpayers, but will also qualify BISD to receive an additional \$100,000 in state funding previously withheld.

Although district officials have maintained a balanced budget in the last few years, infrastructure maintenance and upgrades were desperately needed for the safety of the students.
