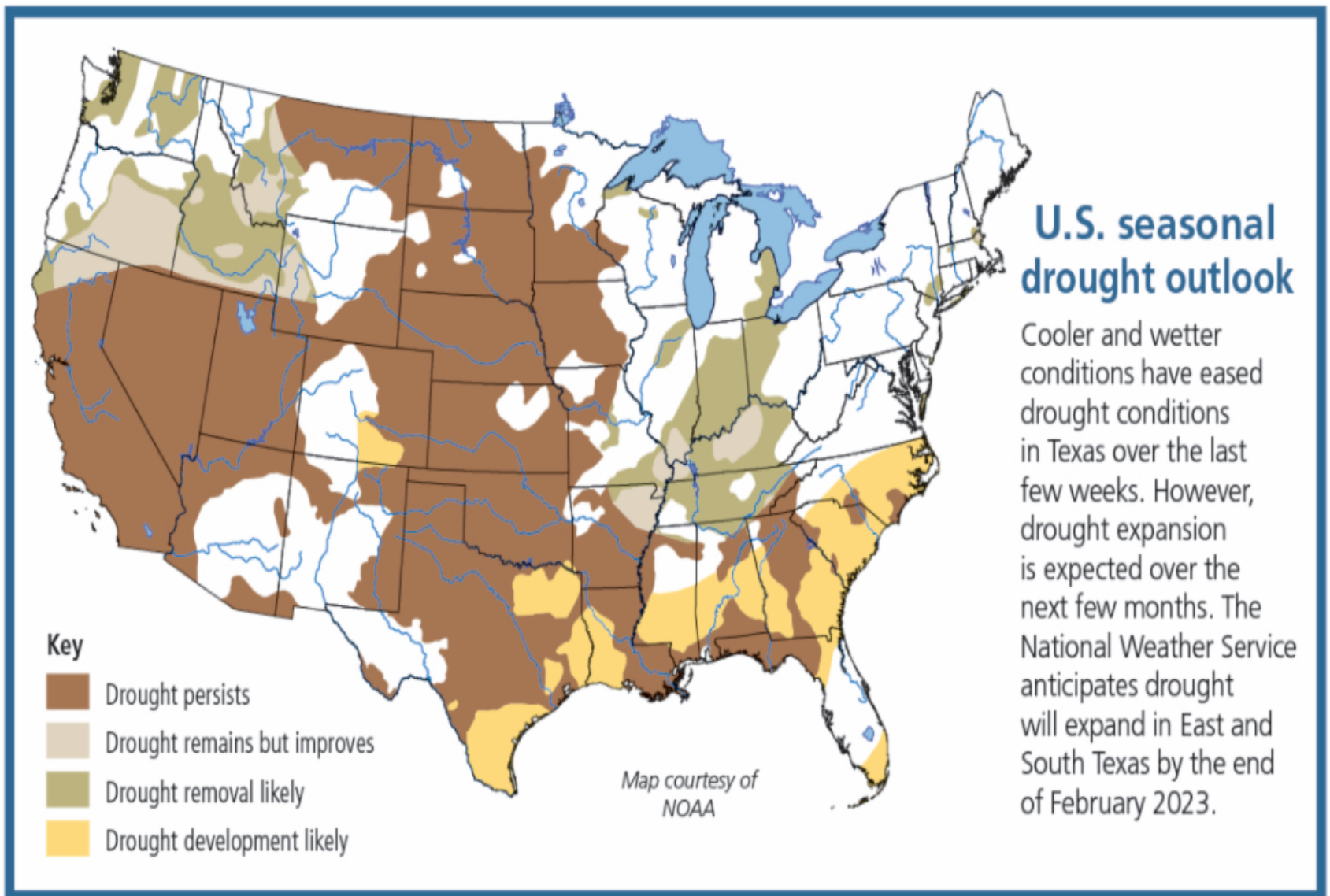
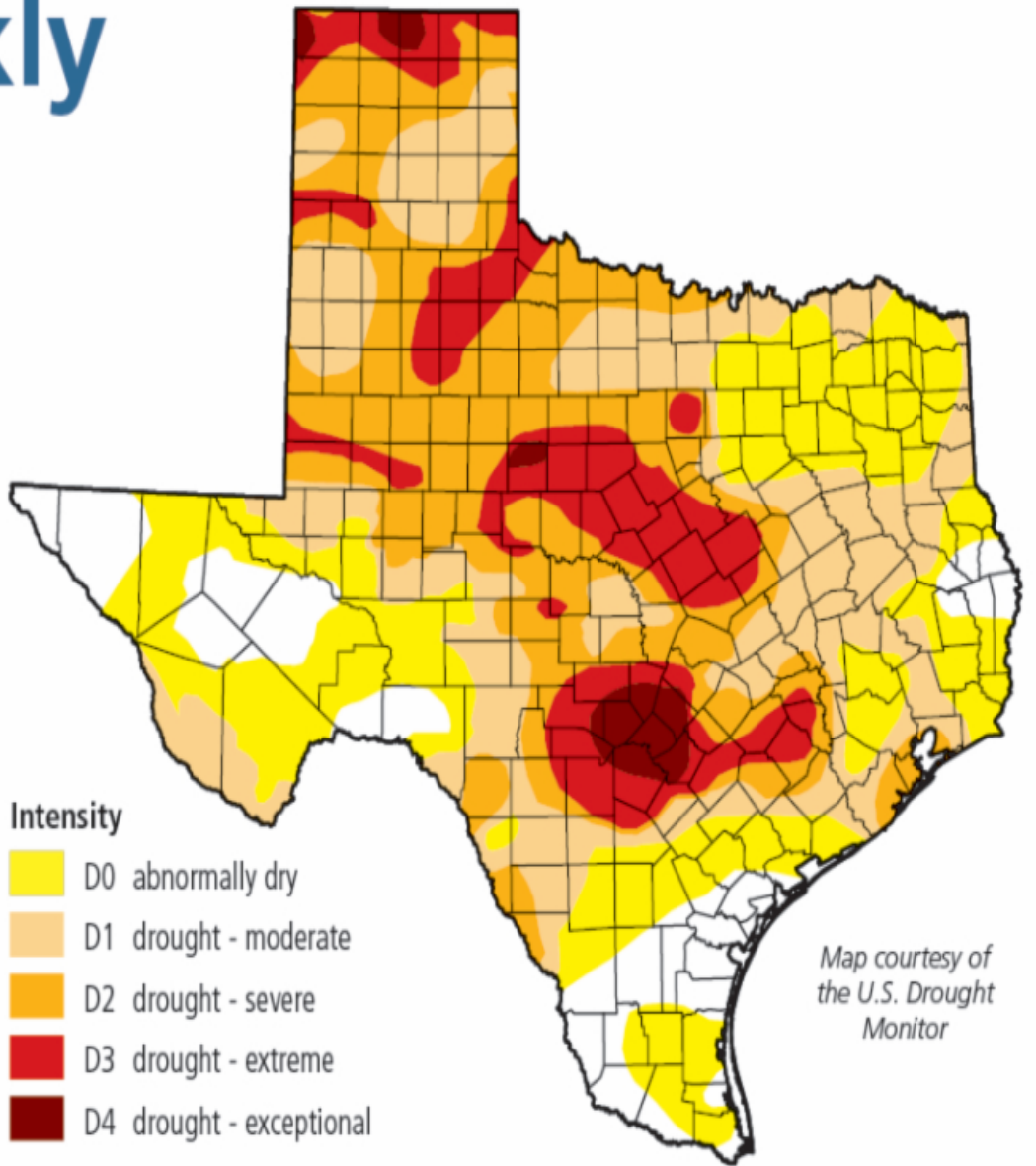

Water conditions

The latest drought monitor map, for conditions as of November 15, shows a decrease in the area of the state impacted by drought for the third consecutive week. Conditions continue to improve in East Texas, but drought is intensifying in parts of Central Texas.

Drought conditions

- 64% now
- 65% a week ago
- 93% three months ago
- 36% a year ago



U.S. seasonal drought outlook

Cooler and wetter conditions have eased drought conditions in Texas over the last few weeks. However, drought expansion is expected over the next few months. The National Weather Service anticipates drought will expand in East and South Texas by the end of February 2023.
