The Coke County Commissioners Court met in regular session November 12, 2013, at the courthouse in Robert Lee. Members of the court present included County Judge, Roy Blair, Commissioner, Pct. #1 Troy Montgomery, Commissioner, Pct. #2 Wendell Lee,

Commissioner, Pct. #3 Gaylon Pitcock, Commissioner, Pct. #4 Bobby Blaylock.

The meeting opened with prayer given by Commissioner Lee and pledge to the flag was recited.

Judge Blair announced the presence of a quorum.
