A motion was made by Jonathan Torres to approve of the second reading of Ordinance 1342 - Sewer Taps and Rates. He was seconded by David Lewis and the motion carried with a vote of 3 - 0.

Bronte will be increasing water rates for Robert Lee at the beginning of the calendar year. The City of Robert Lee will match the increase for all of its customers. A motion was made by Jonathan Torres to approve of the first reading of Ordinance 1344 - Water Taps and Rates. He was seconded by Josh Tennison and the motion carried with a vote of 3 - 0.

Personnel Policy amendments are to be written by City Attorney Jeff Betty.

Secretary's Report

Servpro will be in tomorrow to re-inspect the conference room to assess what else needs to be completed. Another bill cycle needs to run to make sure everything is being calculated correctly with the kiosk. Curbside pickup will be October 16. There were 9 disconnections and all were turned back on upon payment.

Superintendent's Report

There were 39 work orders, 1 sewer tap, and no sewer stops. Clayton Crook has minimal work left on the garage reconstruction. The outside stucco needs to be painted and the outdoor electrical needs to be installed. There was the first overage of the year from Bronte and the tiered system is handling it well. Chlorine conversion has started and should end around October 6. Flushing of hydrants will begin next week. Nuisance abatements are as follows: 40 properties total, 21 mowed by the city and 7 remaining.

The ACO Officer would like to seal the concrete floor at the pound to mitigate odors. The item was requested to be added to a future agenda.

A motion was made by David Lewis to adjourn the meeting at 7:09 pm. He was seconded by Jonathan Torres and the motion carried with a vote of 3 - 0.
