## Pasture, range and forage insurance deadline nears

Coke County farmers and ranchers are reminded the deadline to sign up and report acreage for pasture, range and forage insurance for 2014 is Nov. 15.

"Insurance is a critical component of many operations because farming and ranching is a gamble," said John Ross Copeland, Coke County Farm Bureau president. "The policy can offer stability during these consecutive years of drought and other extreme adverse conditions."


Producers can determine any number of acres to insure, but must also select a minimum of two-month intervals or a maximum of six two-month intervals per year to insure. Payment is determined by area losses based on a grid system, not by indiCoverage levels between 70 and 90 percent are available. "After the producer selects a coverage level, then a productivity factor, which is a percentage of the established county base value for forage, is chosen," John Ross Copeland said.
