The board reviewed the bank statements and petty cash reconciliation. The credit card statement had not been received as of board meeting time.

The board reviewed all bills that have been paid.

The board took a brief recess

at 5:52 pm.

The board moved to executive session at 5:55 pm.

After completion of the executive session at 6:14 pm, Gina McCutchen moved that facility employees be reimbursed for mileage at \$0.55 per mile when using personal vehicle for BHRC business. The motion, seconded by Jerita Taylor, carried unanimously.

Jerita Taylor moved that Administrator Daisy Gomez be added as an authorized signer on the General Operating and Payroll bank accounts. Other signers will remain the same and Ken Petty will be removed. There will be no change to the Savings account. Gina McCutchen seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Lanette Fletcher moved that Administrator Daisy Gomez's monthly salary be increased \$500 per month effective with this pay period and to remove her probation. The motion, seconded by Jerita Taylor, carried unanimously.

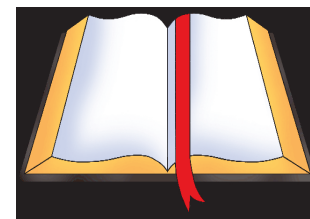
