## West Coke County Hospital Board Meeting minutes posted

The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in regular session October 31, 2012. Vice President Dessie Kendall called the meeting to order at 9:34 AM, and declared a quorum was present. Board members present were Sarah Green, Pat Stephens, and Dessie Kendall, and Patsy Cason. Also present were Roger Alexander, Administrator, and Janie Munoz, Business Office Mgr. Patsy Cason gave the invocation. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved, and there were no absent Board members from that meeting.

The Board went into Executive session at 9:36 AM to discuss personnel matters, and returned to regular session at 9:50 AM. After returning to regular session, the Board voted to hire Patsy Cason, Board Member, as interim DON effective 11-2-12. Patsy will receive pay during this interim, and recuse herself from Board discussion on personnel and nursing matters. She will not sign checks. The Board sincerely appreciates her expertise and

willingness to help out in this capacity during the time of searching for a permanent DON.

In his staffing update, Roger Alexander reported challenges with having a sufficient number of CNA's employed at the facility. He is working to alleviate the problem. In the census count, there are currently 41 residents in the Care Center as of the meeting date.

Under capital projects, the Board discussed furnishings for the Alzheimer's Unit, and the yard behind the Unit. Ideas were presented to enhance the appearance and safety of the yard. A bid will be taken from Justice Construction, and a decision will be made whether or not to proceed with the yard when the final bid is received. The renovation work in the Unit is steadily progressing.

The employee's Christmas party will be held in the dining room of the facility, December 18. Longevity checks, as well as some lovely door prizes, will be given to the employees at that time.

Roger informed the Board of the need to raise the rate for Medicare Skilled and Private Intensive Care. The Board voted to raise the rate

according to the need. Roger also shared that he will be using a lab out of Lubbock, Precision Labs, to draw labs for the facility Monday through Friday.

Accounts receivable were discussed, and the financial statements were discussed and accepted.

Future agenda items were discussed and the meeting was adjourned. The next regular meeting will be November 27, 2012. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend.
