New flexibilities allowed in order to meet the "1 in 4" requirement include:

The annual regrowth for an insured perennial crop, such as alfalfa, red clover, or mint, to be considered planted. Allow a crop covered by the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) to meet the insurability requirement. If crop insurance or NAP coverage was not available, allow the farmer to prove the acreage was planted and harvested using good farming practices in at least two consecutive years out of the four previous years to meet the insurability requirement.

## "1 in 4" requirement flexibilities

For the 2020 crop year, RMA implemented a policy stating that for land to be eligible for prevented planting coverage, the acreage must meet the "1 in 4" requirement, which means the land must be planted, insured and harvested in at least one of the four most recent crop years. Now, RMA is adding flexibilities to recognize different farming practices and crops grown, as well as the availability of risk management options.
