2016 Primary Election Filing Period ends next Monday

The filing period for the March 1, 2016, Democratic and Republican primaries began Saturday, November 14, 2015, and will end next Monday, December 14, 2015, at 6 pm.

County offices up for election include Coke County Commissioners in Precincts 1 and 3, currently held by Gene Montgomery and Gaylon Pitcock; County Constables in Precincts 1 and 2, currently held by Marshall Millican and Marty Boyd respectively; County Attorney, currently held by Nancy Arthur; County Tax

Assessor/Collector, currently held by Josie Dean; and County Sheriff, currently held by Wayne McCutchen. At presstime, Wayne McCutchen and Marty Boyd have filed to retain their offices. Shaunna Grantham, Donald Robertson and Michael Salls have filed for Precinct 1 Commissioner. Marshall Millican has filed for Precinct 3 Commissioner. The above filings are for the Republican Primary. Charles Yorke has filed for Precinct 3 Commissioner in the Democrat Primary.
