Alice was born November 3, 1919, in Alvin, Texas, to George A. and Myrtle Moulton Baxter. She graduated from Alvin High School, serving as President of the Class of 1937.

Following graduation, Alice met the love of her life, Fred Lane Beaty. They were married on December 23, 1939, in Alvin. Shortly after their marriage, they moved to South Texas where Fred worked with Sun Oil Company. Three children were born to them: George Ann, Nancy Rebecca (Becky) and Earl Lane.
