The Audubon Society annual Christmas Bird Count will be held in and around Robert Lee on January 4, 2014. The group will meet at Twisters' for breakfast and Last Leg for lunch. Once a year the Audubon Society conducts a bird count to study the effects of weather, water, and habitat on wild birds which are sometimes called the "canary in the mine" regarding the earthly environment. There are some 90 bird species living or migrating through Coke County. The documentation of the bird count will be distributed some time following the national count.

Some of the group will be staying at Mt. Creek Lodge. Rose Marie Storz is the compiler for the event. Bird counters come from Midland/Odessa, Dallas/Ft.
