Ballots set in 2022 Primary Election

The filing period for the March 1, 2022, primary election ended Monday, December 13, 2021, at 6 pm.

Offices up for election include County Judge, currently held by Hal Spain; County Treasurer, currently held by Therese Emert; Justice of the Peace, currently held by Russell Johnson; County/District Clerk, currently held by Monica Reyes; Commissioner Precincts 2, currently held by Paul Williams; and Commissioner Precinct 4, currently held by Joe Sefcik.

The following incumbents have filed for re-election in the Republican Primary by turning in their forms and filing fee to Republican County Chair Deborah Bailey: County Judge Hal Spain, County Treasurer Therese Emert, Justice of the Peace Russell Johnson, and Precinct 4 Commissioner Joe

Sefcik. County/District Clerk Monica Reyes turned in her forms and a petition in lieu of the filing fee to Mrs. Bailey.

New candidates filing for the Republican Primary election include Ashley McCutchen Braswell for the office of County/District Clerk, Henry Chisholm for the office of Commissioner, Precinct 2 and George Ray Sparks for the office of Commissioner, Precinct 4. These three candidates turned in their forms and filing fees to Republican County Chair Deborah Bailey.

County Judge Hal Spain on Monday received Declarations of Intent to run as an Independent candidate in the November general election from Paul Williams, the current Precinct 2 Commissioner, and Jennifer Burdett for County/ District Clerk.
