The Board of Directors of the West Coke County Hospital District met in a zoom meeting Dec. 15, 2020. VP Pat Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:45 am, declared a quorum was present, and gave the invocation. Board members present were Noel Tinkler, and Judie Andrews. Houston McGuire, RLCC Administrator, and Janie Munoz, BOM, were also present at the meeting. Chris Martin, Consultant, joined the meeting at 10:00 am. The minutes from



the previous meeting on October 13th, were approved and there were no absentees from that meeting.

The Administrator gave his report.

There are 38 residents in the Care Center as of the meeting date, with one possibly pending. The facility is currently well staffed, although PRN staff is always needed.

Under building maintenance, Houston reported that all inside work is still on hold due to the Covid pandemic. Only the necessary repairs are being done at this time.

The facility is still providing senior meals for Bronte as well as Robert Lee.

Daily reporting to the State because of Covid ended Dec. 8.

The new boiler is almost in; still waiting on the air handler unit. Houston will notify the Board of completion.

The policy for EMS & Firefighters, as well as Sick Time Off, was tabled.

The Board voted to accept Robert Brock's resignation with regret.

The Board voted on 3 requests for property bids.

Under Transportation, Houston has received one bid on a smaller van. He and Chris Martin will continue to make inquiries.

The financial statements were not complete. They will be reviewed at a later date.

Future agenda items were discussed and the next regular meeting date is Jan. 26, 2020, at 9:30 am. The meeting was



adjourned at 10:45.
