OH! Christmas TREES!

Christmas trees are a part of the holiday season for many in the United States. The trees are often highlighted in many Christmas carols. Some prefer artificial trees and others can't imagine a holiday season without a real tree.

HERE ARE SOME FACTS ABOUT CHRISTMAS TREES THAT YOU MAY NOT KNOW:

* There are approximately **25-30 MILLION** real Christmas trees sold in the U.S. every year.



* There are close to **350 MILLION** real Christmas trees currently growing on Christmas tree farms in the U.S. and all of them have been planted by farmers.

For every real Christmas tree harvested, **ONE TO THREE** seedlings are planted the following spring.

* It can take as many as 15 years to grow a tree of typical height (six-seven feet) or as little as four years, but the average growing time is **SEVEN YEARS.**

There are more than **4,000** local Christmas tree-recycling programs throughout the United States.

There are about **350,000** acres in production for growing Christmas trees in the U.S.

There are close to **15,000** farms growing Christmas trees in the U.S. and over **100,000** people are employed full or part-time in the industry.

The most common Christmas tree species are: Balsam fir, Douglas fir, Fraser fir, Noble fir, Scotch pine, Virginia pine and white pine.



* Although real Christmas trees are grown in all 50 states. The top Christmas tree producing states are Oregon, North Carolina, Michigan, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin and Washington.

* Since 1966, the National Christmas Tree Association has given a Christmas tree to the U.S. president and first family for display in the Blue room in the White House.
