Deployments include: Operation Joint Endeavor, Bosnia, March 96-December 96, Operation Iraqi Freedom, April 03-April 04, Operation New Dawn, July 11-Dec 11, Operation Spartan Shield January 12-July 12.

SFC Wilkes has held the following leadership positions including Team Leader, Squad Training Leader, NCO, Petroleum Inventory NCO, Arctic Light Infantry Course (ALIT) Instructor, Section Chief, and Platoon Sergeant.
