PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF ROBERT LEE December 9, 2011

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") sets minimum water quality standards for public drinking water. These standards include enforceable treatment technique requirements for drinking water. Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches.

The Robert Lee Water System failed to meet the minimum daily treatment technique requirements on November 14th – 30th, 2011. Specifically, our water system allowed the turbidity of the filtered water to exceed 1.0 Nephelometric Turbidity Units.

Additionally, The Robert Roger Lee Water System failed to meet the minimum treatment technique requirements for the month of November, Specifically, our water system allowed the turbidity of the filtered water to exceed 0.3 Nephelometric Turbidity Units in more than percent of the measurements made during the month.
